

Resolución de 02/11/2021, del Rector de la Universitat Politècnica de València, por la que se convocan una ayuda para el Programa de Residencia AR(t)IBMCP. Vicerrectorado Arte, Ciencia, Tecnología y Sociedad

To be regulated by the terms and conditions contained in this call and in Annex 1.

FIRST. PURPOSE OF THE CALL

The purpose of this call is to grant an award to the person selected in the AR(t)IBMCP residency program for the 2021/2022 academic year who accredits compliance with the requirements stipulated in the regulatory terms and conditions of the procedure.

SECOND. BUDGET CREDIT AND GRANT AMOUNT

This call for applications shall be financed from budget item **009010000-422-40000**, for a total amount of 3,000 €, there being adequate and sufficient budgetary credit.

The grant will be 3,000 € corresponding to the prize for the person selected in the AR(t)IBMCP residency program.

The economic endowment of the grant will be subject to the corresponding withholding established in the regulations in force.

The UPV Artist-in-Residence Program includes, in addition to this endowment, another one for production expenses of up to 8,500 €, as well as up to 2,500 € for travel, accommodation and living expenses, as shown in Annex 1.

THIRD. TARGET

Artists (over 18 years of age) from all countries are eligible to apply for this grant.

Applicants must meet the following requirements by the end of the application period:

- Have completed and submitted all the requested documentation.

FOURTH. DOCUMENTATION AND APPLICATION DEADLINE

Those who wish to apply for any of these grants must submit:

Applications must be accompanied by the following documentation:

- A short personal testimonial video in which the artist explains why he/she is applying for the residency (Up to 1 min.).
- Description of the artwork to be researched and created as part of the residency.
- Brief description of the artist's expectations regarding collaboration with the scientists, and resources needed
- Project production plan for the artistic research, timeline and cost estimate.

The application form and the other documentation should preferably be submitted through the UPV's electronic registry:

If all the documentation cannot be sent electronically, the other documentation will be sent by e-mail to <artibmcp@upv.es>, from where a reply will be sent acknowledging receipt of the documentation. Without this acknowledgement of receipt, the documentation necessary for admission will not be understood to have been delivered. It may also be sent to the address indicated through the UPV file exchange platform <<https://intercambio.upv.es/>>.

When it is not possible to send the application and documentation in the indicated way, it may be delivered through any of the UPV Registry offices or by any of the means established in Article 16.4 of Law 39/2015, of October 1, of the Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administrations in Spain. The deadline for submitting applications begins on the day following the publication of the extract of this resolution in the Official Gazette of the Generalitat Valenciana and ends on December 30, 2021.

If the application does not meet the requirements established in the call, the competent body will require the interested party to correct it within a maximum and non-extendable period of 10 days, indicating that if he/she does not do so, he/she will be considered to have withdrawn his/her application.

The application submission implies the acceptance of the rules, as well as the obligations derived from the legal framework regarding grants and subsidies.

FIFTH. SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Vice-Rectorate for Art, Science, Technology and Society will be responsible for the instruction of the procedure. The publication medium of any act issued will be the web page <https://acts.webs.upv.es/?lang=en&p=convocatorias>.

A Selection Committee will be appointed to evaluate and propose the winner. In all cases the Commission will submit the proposal to the Rector for the final decision.

The Selection Committee may declare the award void if the candidatures do not meet the required quality or for other reasons, which will be duly justified and the proposal will be submitted to the Rector for final resolution.

The Commission will resolve any incidents that may arise during the call for proposals with objectivity and transparency.

The Vice-Rector's Office responsible of the call and the Selection Committee undertake not to disseminate, transmit or disclose to third parties any information in their own interest or in the interest of third parties in relation to the projects presented.

The names of all candidates who have applied and meet the requirements will be published on the website <https://acts.webs.upv.es/?lang=en&p=convocatorias> and will also be communicated to all interested parties via e-mail.

The evaluation and proposal of the winners will be carried out by a Selection Commission composed of (5 members: 2 persons appointed by the IBMCP, Vice-Rector for Art, Science, Technology and Society, Director of the Cultural Action Area, external expert in Art/Science). The Commission will select and propose the winner, once the applications have been reviewed and the evaluation criteria have been applied, with the documentation provided.

SIXTH. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Grants will be awarded on a competitive basis.

The scales and evaluation criteria applied will be objective, non-discriminatory and will respect the principle of equality.

The applications submitted will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- Characteristics of the project: quality, objectives, formats, expectations (25%).
- Project's relation to the SDGs of the 2030 Agenda (10%)
- Adequacy of the requested resources to the proposed objectives (20%)
- Organizational aspects and planning (20%)
- Portfolio, CV and Video 1' (25%)

SEVENTH. BENEFICIARIES' RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

Grant winners are obliged to:

- Accept the terms and conditions of this call.
- Give a lecture at the beginning and another at the end of the residency at the IBMCP of the UPV.
- Maintain a public blog that will be offered by the UPV to document their artistic-scientific experience and their work process during the residency. The acronyms of the IBMCP and the UPV will always be present in this blog.
- Present prototypes or works in progress at the CCCC.
- Attend the assembly and presentation of the exhibition at the CCCC.

Groups and institutions linked to the AR(t)IBMCP Residency Program are asked to nominate a representative to fulfill this commitment.

- To include the following acknowledgement in all future exhibitions and documentation of the work: This project/work was developed in the AR(t)IBMCP Residency Program in cooperation with the CCCC, the IBMCP and the Universitat Politècnica de València.

All property rights and any other rights remain with the artist.

Failure to comply with these obligations, as well as failure to present the corresponding supporting documentation, will result in the loss of the grant and, if applicable, the return of the amounts already received.

EIGHTH. SELECTION PROCEDURE AND RESOLUTION

The applications submitted shall be reviewed by the Selection Committee, which shall draw up a proposed resolution that shall include the provisional list of those admitted/beneficiaries and those excluded, which shall be published at <<https://acts.webs.upv.es/?lang=en&p=convocatorias>>.

Once the proposed resolution has been published, the interested parties will have 10 working days to present allegations and provide the documents they deem pertinent, starting from the day following the date of publication.

At the end of the period for presenting allegations and having studied the same, the definitive list of those admitted and excluded will be published and the Committee will submit the proposal to the Rector, who will resolve the call for applications.

For notification purposes, the final results will be published on the website <<https://acts.webs.upv.es/?lang=en&p=convocatorias>> no later than January 31, 2022. Additionally, the beneficiaries will be notified in their e-mail account.

All decisions taken will be reasoned.

Beneficiaries must confirm acceptance of the award or waiver by February 10, 2022. Confirmation of acceptance or waiver will be handled by the Vice-Rector's Office for Art, Science, Technology and Society.

NINTH. PROTECTION PERSONAL DATA

In compliance with the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation EU 2016/679 and the Organic Law 3/2018, of December 5, on the Protection of Personal Data and guarantee of digital rights, we inform you that the data controller of the data processed for the purpose of this call is the Universitat Politècnica de València. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is the need to manage the award procedure of this call. No international transfers of the personal data processed are foreseen. Interested parties may exercise their rights of access, rectification, deletion, portability, limitation or opposition to processing by providing a copy of an official document that identifies them and, where appropriate, documentation supporting their request to the Data Protection Officer of the Universitat Politècnica de València, General Secretariat. The data will be kept in accordance with the legislation applicable to this treatment.

TENTH. APPEALS

Against this call and its rules, as well as against the resolution of this call, which exhaust the administrative channels, an appeal for reversal may be lodged before the Rectorate of the UPV within one month, counted from the day following the day of its publication, in accordance with the provisions of articles 123 and 124 of Law 39/2015, of October 1, of the Common Administrative Procedure of the Public Administrations, or contentious-administrative appeal before the bodies of contentious-administrative jurisdiction of the Valencian Community, within two months counted from the day following the day after the notification of this resolution, in accordance with articles 14 and 46 of Law 29/1998, of July 13, regulating the Contentious-Administrative Jurisdiction.
